

THE FIRST TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

The first transnational project meeting was organized by the school Sv. Andreja Svorada a Benedikta Skalité, Slovakia. It was held on the anticipated time 4th – 7th November 2017 with the participation of two teachers of both partner schools. Coordinators of Slovakia, Romania and Greece met together in Tatranská Lomnica.



All planned sessions were realized.

The project activities for the first year were revised and detailed planning how to carry them out was made. The Slovak coordinator presented the proposal on the first planned short term exchange of

students in Slovakia, February 2018. All participants had a guided tour through Tatranská Lomnica, Tatranské Matliare, Starý Smokovec and the ski resort, where the short term exchange of students is going to be held. From Vysoké Tatry participants moved to Skalité. They visited the host school. The



headmistress Edita Špilová warmly welcomed the visitors and introduced the teaching staff. The guests met Slovak pupils, talked with them about their towns, schools and pupils and answered their questions. The coordinators presented their countries, regions, schools and project

progress that had been done at schools. The Slovak pupils performed some traditional dances and songs. There was a discussion on educational systems of participating countries.

Afterwards, the visitors had an excursion on the school buildings and its facilities. They visited the local church and



the kindergarten where the headmistress presented their work and discussed with the guests

the similarities and differences of their work among the countries. The tour ended with a pleasant get-together in the local restaurant. The guests learnt about Slovak culture and traditions through the guidance of hosting school staff and had the opportunity to share their experiences.
