Most students know (90%), what trade means and what is involved.

Joiner/Carpenter - because I enjoy working with wood

I like the trade of coachman - the horseman, which I did not know anything about. It was nice to find out something about it, to get close to it as I did not have the opportunity before.


Sewing folk costumes - because they were made by my great grandmother

The questionnaire revealed that the students learned a lot, gained new knowledge not only about trades and occupations in the family but they were thinking about the direction in which their future education should advance.
