



THE FIRST LEARNING AND TRAINING ACTIVITY

The first Learning and Training Activity was organized by the school

Sv. Andreja Svorada a Benedikta Skalité, Slovakia. It was held on the anticipated time



3rd – 10th February 2018 with the participation of three teachers and nine students of each partner school. Students from Greece and Romania were placed in Slovak host families. The welcoming of the participants took place at the

primary school building, as the Slovak tradition says, by bread and salt. The opening ceremony was attended by pupils and teachers of all partner



schools, parents and the Mayor of the village PaedDr. Andrea Šimurdová, who personally welcomed a foreign delegation. The cultural program was associated with the

introduction of all countries and schools. Talented pupils of the Slovak school presented their talent and Slovak culture in the form of dance, music and



singing. Greek students surprised the audience by presenting their folk dance. Participants were invited for a tour of the village, school buildings, kindergarten, church and many

activities under the guidance of Slovak students,

teachers and parents. Each country has prepared and presented its traditional dishes. Every participant had the opportunity to create his own T-shirt with a Slovak folk motive. International teams created posters to present their countries and regions. The sport

competition Winter Race of mixed international teams was based on communication and collaboration of students in various disciplines. The carnival was associated with the creation of masks and costumes that represented famous personalities from the history, mythology and presence of all



countries. Final part of the carnival was the project mega cake, which was served at the final disco. The second part of the meeting was held in the High Tatras, where visitors together with Slovak students learned to ski, expanded

their vocabulary of sports terminology, played international tournaments in ringo, floorball, football, table tennis, volleyball and basketball, enjoyed a swimming pool, snow activities, museums in Pribilina and High Tatras, hiking tours. They could gain information on ski history of Slovakia, see the Ice Dome in Hrebienok, visit Rainer's cottage, spent a pleasant time in optical illusion space of Tricklandia. The lecture with rescuers, movies, games and evening animation programs focused not only on pupils' physical activity, but also



on mutual learning, improving communication skills in English, Slovak culture and sport.
